
Schertz-Seguin Local Government Corporation (SSLGC) would like to take this opportunity to submit comments regarding the Region L South Central Texas Regional Water Plan. Our project is WMS #19 in the Initially Prepared Plan (IPP) as shown in Figure 1.

SSLGC recommends the following:

1. Revise the IPP to have a single pipeline which conveys water from western Gonzales County through Guadalupe County to Bexar County and includes the Regional Carrizo for SAWS (WMS #18), Wells Ranch for CRWA (WMS #27) and SSLGC (WMS #19).
2. Oversize the pipeline in order to carry future water generated from the Simsboro Project (WMS #21) and TWA Regional Carrizo (WMS #36) and transported to Bexar and/or Comal Counties
3. Participate with the Texas Water Development Board to oversize the pipeline using the State Participation Program as shown in Figure 2.

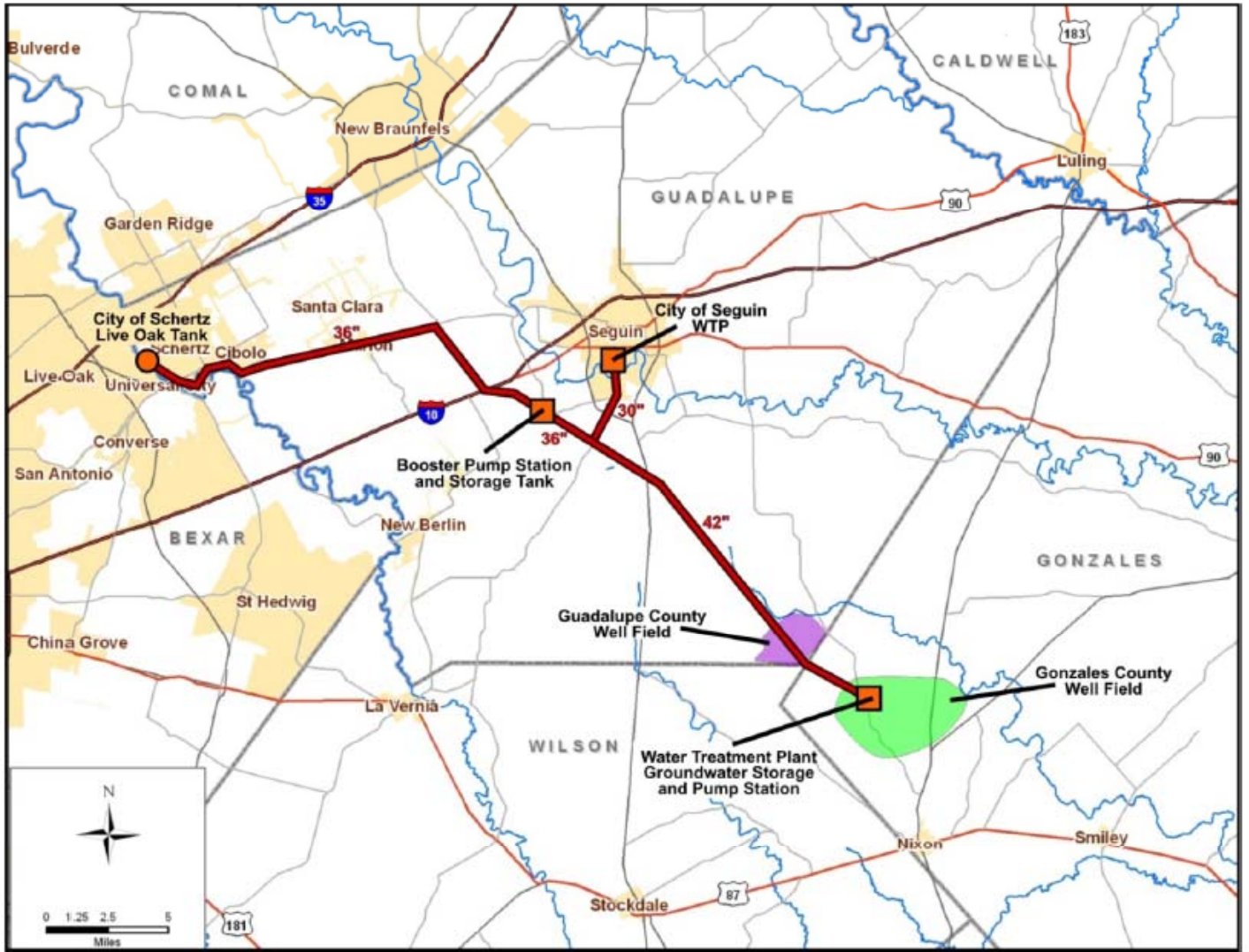


Figure 4C.19-1. Schertz-Seguin Water Supply Project
