Key SCTRWPG Activities/Actions Leading to Adoption of the 2006 Initially Prepared South Central Texas Regional Water Plan

January 13, 2005 (SWG = 12/16/2004)

- 1) Workshop on policy issues and legislative recommendations (committee meeting 2/4/2005).
- 2) Identify potentially feasible Water Management Strategies (WMS).
- 3) Review WMS technical evaluations.

February 3, 2005 (SWG = 1/20/2005)

- 1) Review WMS technical evaluations (incl. Municipal Conservation & “highest practicable”).
- 2) Identify potentially feasible WMS.
- 3) Select technical assumptions for assessment of cumulative effects of Plan.

March 10, 2005 (SWG = 2/24/2005)

- 1) Review WMS technical evaluations.
- 2) Identify potentially feasible WMS.
- 3) Discuss policy issues and legislative recommendations (incl. unique stream segments, etc.).
- 4) Consider proposed changes to meeting schedule.

March 31, 2005 Special Workshop (SWG = 3/24/2005)

- 1) Receive draft Planning Area Description, Demands, Supplies, and Needs sections of Plan.
- 2) Review WMS technical evaluations.
- 3) Review Needs by county along with recommended WMS.
- 4) Review Needs by Wholesale Water Provider (WWP) along with recommended WMS.
- 5) Select WMS for assessment of cumulative effects of Plan.

April 7, 2005 Moved to April 21, 2005

April 21, 2005 (SWG = 4/7/2005)

- 1) Review assessment of cumulative effects (e.g., environmental, socio-economic, etc.) of Plan.
- 2) Consider consistency of the Plan with long-term protection of the State’s resources.
- 3) Review social & economic effects of rural to urban transfers.
- 4) Receive draft Executive Summary and Initially Prepared Plan.

May 5, 2005

- 1) Review SCTRWPG comments on draft Initially Prepared 2006 Regional Water Plan.

May 26, 2005 (SWG = 5/12/2005)

- 1) Adopt Initially Prepared 2006 Regional Water Plan.
