On October 23, 2012 the Springs Hill Board of Directors voted to pass a resolution in support of what we are calling the "Regional Carrizo for Guadalupe Basin" recommended water management strategy for Springs Hill and others. This would involve the construction and installation of a water transmission pipeline that travels through northeast Guadalupe County. This resolution is attached.

Currently all major pipelines travel through the southern area of Guadalupe County. With the completion of the new State Highway 130 entering Interstate 10 in the northeast portion of Guadalupe County we expect a tremendous amount of growth in the area and currently no one has the ability to provide the water this growth will demand. The City of Seguin, the County Commissioners Court and Springs Hill all have a vested interest in the water coming from the new well fields in Gonzales County to bring water close to the interstate and then on to other areas on the other side of Guadalupe County. The first phase of this project could come from the current Mesa Wells, CRWA Wells Ranch and/or Schertz Seguin Well Field. This I have indicated as segment A on the attached map. Then at later date bringing water in through segment B from the new well fields now pursuing permits from the Gonzales Underground Water Conservation District.

We ask that a regional solution be evaluated and incorporated into the 2016 plan.

**RESOLUTION REGARDING RECOMMENDATIONS TO REGION L WATER
PLANNING GROUP CONCERNING RECOMMENDED WATER STRATEGIES**

WHEREAS, Springs Hill Water Supply Corporation (“Springs Hill”) is a nonprofit member owned water supply corporation organized pursuant to Texas Revised Civil Statutes Annotated article 1434a, as amended, and operating under Texas Water Code, Chapter 67;

WHEREAS, Springs Hill’s water service area is entirely within the Region L South Central Texas Regional Water Planning Group (“Region L”);

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Chapters 357 and 358 of Title 31 of the Texas Administrative Code, Region L develops a water plan for its area every five years, in part (i) identifying the anticipated population growth, (ii) estimating the present and future water demands, (iii) inventorying existing water supplies, and (iv) recommending water strategies to meet those water needs now and in the future;

WHEREAS, Region L is currently soliciting input from water suppliers operating within the Region regarding preparation of the 2016 Region L Regional Water Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Springs Hill desires to provide its recommendation to the Region L Water Planning Group regarding a certain proposed water transmission pipeline.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SPRINGS HILL WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The above recited definitions and facts are true and correct and adopted herein for all purposes.


